ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.(ORAL) :

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Panipat, has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

As per the reply, respondent No.4 had made a statement before the police on 06.04.2018 that his daughter Moni i.e. petitioner No.1, was abducted by a contractor namely Meer Hassan i.e.petitioner No.2, who is aged about 50 years, married and already having four children. In that regard, an FIR No.349 dated 18.06.2018, under Sections 363/366 IPC, Police Station Quilla, Panipat was registered. Thereafter petitioner No.1 was produced before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Panipat and she had made a statement under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. As per her statement, on 18.06.2018, when she had gone to market, petitioner No.2 Meer Hassan, along with one Aakil met her and said that her brother

was kidnapped and if she wants to see him alive, she should accompany them. From there, she was brought to Chandigarh and under the threat of life and under intoxication Meer Hassan committed rape upon her. Thereafter, on 23.06.2018, she was left by him at Panipat and thereafter, counselling of the petitioner was done and she was medico legally examined. Both Meer Hassan and Aakil have been arrested by the police and in his disclosure statement, Meer Hassan-petitioner No.2 had admitted the commission of offence.

In view of the same, no further orders are required in this petition.

The petition stands disposed of.
