Present petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.4 to 11.

As per reply of the respondents-State, during the course of enquiry, all the private respondents joined the enquiry proceedings and stated that they never threatened the petitioners and the petitioners also joined the enquiry proceedings and stated that now they are living happily and do not have any threat apprehension. Learned State counsel contended that the petitioners stayed happily in the Safe Home from 03.07.2018 to 10.07.2018.

Moreso, there is no representation from the petitioners' side and it appears that the petitioners are not interested to pursue the present petition. As such, the present petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
