Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. in the FIR No. 72 dated 9.3.2018 under Sections 379B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (added lateron), registered at Police Station 'A' Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no identification parade was conducted as per the law. He further submits that even as per the best case of the prosecution, the petitioner alleged to have been standing outside and the other co-accused was committing crime in the shop. It is further submitted that in the name of recovery, the police has taken licensed revolver of the father of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 14.3.2018.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, being instructed from ASI Waris Masih, submits that pistol has been recovered from the petitioner. He further submits that there is one more FIR in the same police station involving the petitioner.

In view of the above submissions of the counsel for the petitioner but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail pending trial, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
