Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for seeking anticipatory bail in the FIR No. 79 dated 7.4.2018 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Mauli Jagran, UT, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relied upon the order dated 6.7.2018 passed in CRM-M No. 19476 of 2018, whereby the co-accused of the petitioner; with similar allegations; has already been extended the concession of anticipatory bail.

This fact of grant of anticipatory bail to the co-accused of the petitioner is not disputed by the learned State counsel, who is being instructed by SI Sharminder Singh.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. It is directed that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer on 25.7.2018 or any date thereafter, as required by the police. In case, the petitioner is arrested, then he shall be released on bail by the Arresting Officer on petitioner's furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. The

petitioner shall also comply with other conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.

However, it is made clear that if the petitioner does not appear before the Investigating Officer on the above said given date or any other date thereafter, as required by the Investigating Officer, then the Investigating Officer shall be at liberty to apply for withdrawal of the order passed today.
