The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their lives and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their lives and liberty at their instance.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. S. P. S. Tinna, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 4—State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that a representation dated 19.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to look into grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation dated 19.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.

The validity of the marriage has not been decided in this petition. In case there is any FIR lodged against petitioner No.2, the police would be at liberty to take action in accordance with law.
