This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.228 dated 28.06.2014 registered under Sections 21, 22, 25, 25-A, 27, 29, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Tripri Town, District Patiala and Sections 9, 9A of the NDPS Act and Sections 471 & 489 of IPC(added later on) for the period from 28.06.2018 to 13.07.2018.

The petitioner is in custody in Ambala Central Jail and he moved an application before the trial Court for interim bail on the ground that the marriage of his daughter was fixed for 05.07.2018. The trial Court granted him interim bail for the period from 01.07.2018 to 09.07.2018 and issued directions to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala to make necessary arrangements to carry the petitioner from 01.07.2018 to 09.07.2018 under custody to attend the marriage function.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would not be able to attend some functions and therefore it has been prayed that the interim bail be granted from 28.06.2018 to 13.07.2018.

In our opinion, the necessary relief has already been granted. Consequently, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
