The petitioner has placed on record the affidavit of Mr. Kapil Soni, Director of the accused-Company along with copies of his Appointment and Resignation Letter which was accepted by the Company, in the form of Annexures P-8, P-4 and P-6 respectively in compliance of earlier order dated 1st November, 2017.

2. On going through the contents of the said affidavit sworn by the Company's Director, who is stated to be in Judicial Custody since 29th of January in this case, this Court is of the opinion that detention of the present petitioner would not be

required as the criminal liability has virtually been owned up by the Director himself.

3. As such the interim bail granted to the present petitioner earlier on 19th July, 2017 is ordered to be confirmed.

4. The Authorities shall however be at liberty to seek cancellation of the same if they can come up with any further tangible material to indicate petitioner's personal culpability *qua* the allottees which is at any different level from the liability of the Company's Director.
