Prayer in this petition is for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No. 448 dated 21.12.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is only a clerk with the counsel and the allegation level against him is only filling up of the forms of bail bonds etc. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the co-accused of the petitioner, who had attested the identity of the surety, have already been released on anticipatory bail by the Lower Court. He further submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 31.05.2018.

The above said contentions have not been seriously contested by the State, who has been assisted by ASI Balwinder Singh.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and considering the facts that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 31.05.2018; the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted concession of anticipatory bail by the Lower Court and the conclusion of the trial is likely to

take some time, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
