GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The learned State counsel has today filed reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Sukhamrit Singh Randhawa, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-II, Patiala accompanied by translated copies of statements of father of petitioner No.1 as well as of both the petitioners and also a joint statement of the parties i.e. father of petitioner No.1, brother of petitioner No.1 and of one Rohit Kumar. The same is taken on record. The petitioners are also present in the Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition as the petitioners do not apprehend any threat as on date and that the parents of petitioner No.1-Nitu are agreeable for their residing together and have no objection to their marriage.

In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh one in case there is any

apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners at a later stage.
