LISA GILL, J.

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of an appropriate order and direction for speedy and expeditious conclusion of the trial in FIR No. 203 dated 17.10.2012 registered at Police Station Division No. 5, Ludhiana.

As per the reply filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, there is no delay on the part of the prosecution in conclusion of the trial. It is stated that an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. was moved by the prosecution for summoning eight other persons as an additional accused. This application was declined by the learned trial Court qua seven and accepted in respect to the accused Rupinderjit Kaur vide order dated 10.08.2015. Notice was issued to the said additional accused. She had not appeared before the learned trial Court. Proceedings under Section 82 Cr.P.C. were initiated.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Naseeb Singh, verifies that CRR No. 46 dated 03.11.2016 filed by Rupinderjit Kaur has been allowed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana on

02.11.2017 whereby said Rupinderjit Kaur has been discharged. The said order has not been challenged. The trial, in this case, is likely to be concluded and it is stated that there would be no delay on the part of the prosecution in this case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, no further directions are called for in this matter.

This petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
