Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. Petitioner No.1 is stated to be major and petitioner No.2 is stated to be on verge of majority. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 25.1996

whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of 10th class examination certificate (Annexure P-3) depicting her date of birth as 30.3.2001. They have also moved a representation before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5)

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
