The petitioner Jasvir Kaur Garg seeks grant of regular bail in a case registered against her vide FIR No.94 dated 23.3.2017 under Sections 420 and 406 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Ambala Cantt. District Ambala (P-1).

The allegations in nutshell are that the petitioner Jasvir Kaur Garg had entered into an agreement for sale of her house for an amount of ₹ 35 lacs to the complainant, knowing fully well that the said house was under a pledge and a loan had been raised against it. It is further the case of the prosecution that out of the sale consideration of ₹ 26 lacs, an amount of ₹ 21 lacs has been recovered from the petitioner and her husband.

Notice of this petition was issued to the State.

The learned State counsel has opposed the petition and has submitted that the trial is almost at the fag end and a large number of prosecution witnesses have already been examined. It has been informed that ever since the date of arrest i.e. since 17.9.2017, the petitioner has been behind the bars.

In view of the fact that the trial is already under way and also the fact that the petitioner has been behind the bars since last about 9 months and that the petitioner is a lady, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of regular bail.

In view of discussion made above, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner Jasvir Kaur Garg is ordered to be released released on regular bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly
