The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 439 of Criminal Procedure Code for grant of regular bail in FIR No.159 dated 16.11.2017, under Sections 379-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') (Section 201 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station PAU, Ludhiana.

It has been alleged that Rs.45,000/- was snatched by some unknown person. No Test Identification Parade was conducted. Nothing has been recovered from the petitioners. The application is contested on the ground that four other cases are pending against them.

Custody certificate furnished by learned State counsel is taken on record. As per the same, petitioners are in custody for the last five months and sixteen days. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners in custody since the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

Keeping in view the peculiar circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed and petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety

each to the satisfaction of the learned Area/Duty Magistrate and subject to the conditions, if so imposed, by that court.
