On 10.01.2018, following order was passed by this  
Court:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused Nitin Yadav was accused of preparing fake bills and bulity of truck loaded with 501 boxes of Royal Stag liquor and egg trays. The driver of the truck was Arvind Patel whereas Vikas Kumar was helper. The name of the petitioner appeared only in the disclosure statement of Nitin Yadav who has already been granted interim bail in CRM-M No.43543 of 2017.*

*Notice of motion for 22.01.2018.*

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 15.01.2018 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of*

*Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Thereafter vide order dated 22.01.2018, petitioner was again directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 30.01.2018 and to co-operate in the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the aforesaid orders dated 10.01.2018 and 22.01.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Subhash Chand admitted the aforesaid fact and stated that the petitioner is no more required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim orders dated 10.01.2018 and 22.01.2018 are made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
