Petitioner was earlier facing the trial for the offence under Sections 382/34 of the Indian Penal Code in case FIR No.5 dated 13.02.2013, registered at Police Station Daresi, Ludhiana. He violates the terms and conditions of the bail bonds and was consequently, declared proclaimed offender.

It has been submitted that petitioner was arrested on 7th December, 2017 and since then he is in custody. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody since the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

Keeping in view the peculiar circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety to the satisfaction of the learned Area/Duty Magistrate and subject to the conditions, if so imposed, by that court.
