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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)**

By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks extension of time so as to appear before the trial Court and to furnish bail bonds.

A few facts necessary to notice for disposal of this petition are that the petitioner had been on bail before the learned Trial Court but on account of his absence on 11.10.2017 his bail bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants for securing his presence were issued. Vide order dated 27.06.2018 this Court while issuing notice of motion in the main case had directed the petitioner to appear before learned Trial Court within one week and Trial Court had been directed to release the

petitioner on interim bail. However, despite the aforesaid directions, the petitioner did not choose to surrender and after almost one month of the aforesaid order has now moved the present application for extension of time for surrendering as well as for grant of bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner I find that the aforesaid default is now the second consecutive default on part of the petitioner. As such, I do not find any ground to further extend the period as prayed for. The application for extension of time as well as petition for grant of anticipatory bail are hereby dismissed. However, in case the petitioner chooses to surrender before the trial Court within one week from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within three days thereafter.
