By way of filing the present petition, petitioner seeks quashing of the FIR No. 46 dated 17.07.2015 under Sections 279, 337 and 338 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

As per the statement of complainant-respondent No.2 Satnam Singh, parties have arrived at compromise vide compromise dated 02.06.2017.

Admittedly offences under Sections 279, 337 and 338 are not compoundable, rather these are offences which are not of private type and affect the public at large and are offences against the State. Such type of offences cannot possibly be allowed to be compounded and FIR for this quashed on the basis of compromise.

The petition stands dismissed.
