Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondents No. 4 to 10.

Mr. Malkeet Singh, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the private respondents No. 6, 7, 8 and 10 and states that respondent-sister wants to meet the petitioner No.1.

Allowed as prayed for.

Petitioner No.1 met with respondent-sister in my chamber and states that she still wants to go with petitioner No.2.

The petitioners are living together in live-in relationship against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of their proof of age petitioner No.1 and 2 have placed on record copies of their Aadhar Cards Annexure P-1 and P-2 wherein their date of birth are mentioned as 23.3.1996 and 18.10.1997 respectively. They have also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Panipat (Annexure P-3) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Superintendent of Police, Panipat to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-3).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
