Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondents No. 4 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of their proof of age petitioner No.1 and 2 have placed on record copies of their Aadhar Cards Annexure P-1 and P-2 wherein their date of birth are mentioned as 4.3.1997 and 26.2.2000 respectively. They have also moved a

representation before the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad (Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4)

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
