Avneesh Jhingan, J. (Oral) :

The present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Narwana, District Jind and Station House Officer, Police Station, Uchana, District Jind to protect life and liberty of petitioner No.1 and 2 from the hands of private respondents i.e. respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

Notice of motion.

Sh. Deepak Grewal, D.A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3. Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply four copies of paper books during the course of the day.

In view of nature of order that is being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to the private respondents.

The petitioners are apprehending danger for their life and liberty from private respondents. The petitioner no.2 has left her husband and is living with petitioner no.1. Representation dated 21.06.2018 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted to the respondent no.2.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent no.2 to look into the grievances raised by the petitioners in the representation (Annexure-P3) and in case, there is any threat revealed to the petitioners, appropriate protection be granted.

It is, however, clarified that in case any FIR or criminal proceedings are registered against the petitioners, the authorities would be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.
