In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.65 dated 28.04.2018, under Section 452, 427, 436, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that parties have entered into compromise to that extent separate petition is presented in this court and it is pending consideration.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions of ASI Balwinder Singh has not disputed the above facts and circumstances relating to entering into compromise.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially having regard to the fact that matter has been compromised, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

7. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner- Manjit Singh is ordered to

be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
