Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0055 dated 02.11.2017 registered under Sections 323/324/34 of IPC at Police Station Behrampur, Tehsil and District Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Sarwan Singh, has pointed out that for the relief of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0055 (supra), the petitioners have not approached the learned Sessions Court and have straightaway approached this Court.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioners.

Since there is no such order on record to substantiate that before approaching this Court for the relief of anticipatory bail, the petitioners have approached the learned Sessions Judge, this Court finds that the petitioners are firstly required to approach the learned Sessions Court/Additional

Sessions Judge for the relief claimed in the present petition.

Accordingly, present petition is hereby dismissed.

However, the order dated 27.06.2018 passed by this Court whereby the petitioners were granted ad-interim bail, shall continue to remain in operation for another two weeks enabling the petitioners to approach the Sessions Court for the relief claimed in the present petition. However, till then the petitioners shall not be arrested.

Copy of this order be sent to the counsel for the petitioners.

The SHO concerned is directed to inform the petitioners about this order.
