The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 25.03.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station City Nawanshahar, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Heard.

Learned State counsel on instructions of ASI Jurinder Pal submitted that compromise has been effected by the complainants with petitioner-Gurwinder Kaur and Rs.1,10,000/- paid to the complainants.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also placed on file affidavits of Amninder Singh (Annexure P-2), Sukhwinder Kumar (Annexure P-3) and Gurdeep Singh (Annexure P-4).

Petitioner is in custody since 5th June, 2018. Nothing is to be recovered from her and she is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Gurwinder Kaur daughter of Buta Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) She shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
