Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondents No. 4 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Identity card issued by Election Commission of India (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 3.8.1995 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed

on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 10.5.1993. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without advertng to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
