Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for seeking bail pending trial in the FIR No. 31 dated 7.3.2017 under Sections 302, 427, 323 and 120B IPC (Sections 148 and 149 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Rashwinder Singh, submits that the case has just been committed to the Court of Sessions. Earlier the case could not proceed because the petitioner was absconding and therefore, was declared proclaimed offender. Now the petitioner is in custody and the trial would be completed expeditiously.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to grant the concession of bail pending trial to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
