This petition has been filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The petitioners were granted regular bail vide order dated 13.07.2016. It is contended that the petitioners kept appearing before the Court. However, on 12.04.2018, when the petitioners had come to the court premises for attending the hearing, they were picked up by the police outside the court premises in connection with some other case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners also relied upon the order dated 13.06.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-25760 of 2018 in the case of co-accused.

Keeping in view the facts of the case and the order passed by the Coordinate Bench, it is considered appropriate to dispose of the petition while directing the petitioners to appear before the trial Court within 10

days from today and seek regular bail. In case such an application is filed within the time as directed, the petitioners shall be released on regular bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court concerned.

According, the present petition is disposed of.
