The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 439 of Criminal Procedure Code for grant of regular bail in FIR No.48 dated 27.03.2018, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 342, 364 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (later on Sections 147, 149 deleted and Section 34 of IPC added) registered at Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that now compromise has been effected.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also affirmed this fact.

Petitioners are in custody since 9th April, 2018.

Keeping in view the peculiar circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed and petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety each to the satisfaction of the learned Area/Duty Magistrate and subject to the conditions, if so imposed, by that court.
