The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.171 dated 15.08.2017 registered under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar.

It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely involved in the case which was lodged one day after the incident after making deliberations. It is also contended by the counsel that the complainant has no reason or occasion to know the details regarding the petitioner and other co-accused, whereas she has given the full details of the accused in the FIR, without explaining how she came to know about these details. Counsel further submits that in fact the petitioner was in hospital on that day and was operated upon. The petitioner has also attached the document at Annexure P.2 in that regard.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel on instructions from

ASI Sarwan Singh submits that the co-accused of the petitioner has also

named him as the person involved in the incident. It is further submitted by him that the petitioner is named specifically in the FIR.

However, in view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail. Therefore, it is directed that in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
