The petitioner Parveen Sharma seeks grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No.121 dated 7.6.2018 under Sections 406, 420 and 427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Bajghera, District Gurugram.

The FIR was lodged at the instance of Jyoti Kandari, wherein she alleged that she had sent her household goods and her car through 'M/s United Safe Packers Movers' for transporting the same from New Delhi to Bangalore and that while the household goods were received in broken condition, the car had not been received till date. However, the car was subsequently found lying abandoned in front of house of the accused Parveen Sharma.

Notice of the petition was issued to the State vide order dated 27.6.2018 and the petitioner was granted interim bail and also directed to join investigation.

It has been informed by Shri Vinod Kumar, Assistant Sub Inspector that the petitioner has since joined investigation and is no longer required for any further investigation and that the car in question, in any case, has been recovered.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation and also the fact that the car in question has already been recovered, in my opinion it is fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 27.6.2018 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed.
