Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 25.04.1995 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting her date of birth as 02.10.1996. They have also moved a representation before the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Tarn

Taran (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
