Petitioner, who is facing trial and was granted bail, has filed this petition with the prayer that on 16.04.2018 because of non appearance of the petitioner, bail granted to the petitioner was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited and non bailable warrants were issued. Application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. was also dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner would appear before the Court on 04.08.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also drawn attention of the Court to the order passed by the Coordinate Bench in CRM-M-44553-2017 on 24.11.2017.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that issuance of notice in the present petition is not required.

Petitioner has undertaken to put in appearance on 04.08.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail. If such an application is moved, the Court shall decide the same on the same date. Till then arrest of the petitioner is stayed pursuant to nonailable arrest warrants issued in this case.

However, learned trial Court would be at liberty to pass an order on merits without being influenced by any observation made by this Court.
