On instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh, Police Station Rangar Nangal, the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner in consequence of order dated 28.06.2018 has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute and it is also submitted by learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 that the parties have effected compromise.

In the light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 28.06.2018 is made

absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan).
Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
