1. On 20.07.2017, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on payment of disputed cheque amount, the respondent-complainant had agreed to withdraw his complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, pending adjudication before the trial, vide compromise dated 17.09.2016 (Annexure P-3), but till date the respondent-complainant has not withdrawn the same.

Notice of motion for 25.10.2017.

In the meanwhile, proceedings before the trial Court are stayed.”

2. Today, Mr. Kartar Singh Malik, Advocate, learned counsel for the respondent has appeared and admits the factum of compromise dated 17.09.2016 wherein an amount of Rs.3,60,000/- was received by the respondent and the respondent had agreed that he would withdraw the complaint.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent on behalf of the respondent undertakes to withdraw the complaint within two weeks from today.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent, this petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to get it revived in case the aforesaid undertaking is not fulfilled by the respondent.

5. It is made clear that in the event of any default on behalf of the respondent, the matter shall be dealt with in accordance with law.
