Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.116 dated 06.08.2016 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 11.09.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.
