Prayer in this petition is for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 200 dated 23.04.2018 under Sections 304 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station, Sector -31, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per post mortem report, the injury found on the deceased is only abrasions. In fact, the deceased had suffered heart problem which resulted into the cause of death of the deceased.

On the last date, counsel for the U.T., has taken time to place on record the medical opinion qua the cause of death. Counsel has placed on record the medical opinion dated 30.07.2018, which is taken on record, which shows that the injuries present on the person of the deceased were resuscitation artefacts and that the cause of death in this case is acute coronary insufficiency in a case of pre-existing coronary artery disease, a natural cause.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
