The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to official respondents to proceed against the private respondents for interfering into the religious rights to organise religious functions at Lallan Wala Peer Dargah situated at Village Gujran as Khata No.564/1003.

The present petition has been filed with averments that the petitioner had right to maintain the Dargah situated at the Village and to organise the religious functions at the site. However, the private respondents are interfering in such right of the petitioner. It is further averred that the respondents are adamant to dispossess the petitioner of the property of Dargah and to destroy the holy grave. Still further, it is averred that recital of 101 “Kuran Majid” on the said Dargah is part of the religious ceremony. However, the private respondents have threatened the petitioner and other muslims not to do any religious functions on the spot. With these averments, it is contended that right to religious practice is fundamental right. The private respondents are interfering in the same.

Notice of motion was issued wayback on 14th September,

2016. No reply has been filed in the case. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner even today.

Keeping in view that the disputed questions of facts are involved in the matter, and also the fact that the petitioner appears to have lost interest in the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that no further orders are required in the case.
