AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Virender, Police Station City, Hisar, states that in compliance with the order dated 28.11.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation as of now. He, however, submits that further recovery of the amount due from the petitioner has to be effected.

That cannot be a ground for denying the benefit of concession of bail at this stage, especially keeping in view that the allegations pertain to the year 2013 and 2014 and the FIR has been lodged in the year 2017.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed.

Order dated 28.11.2017 is made absolute.

This shall, however, be subject to the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C.
