This is a petition filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.35 dated 08.05.2016, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, at Police Station City-2, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

The petitioner was granted regular bail by the trial Court. However on 04.06.2018, the petitioner did not appear on account of alleged illness. An application seeking exemption from personal appearance was filed on behalf of the petitioner. However, since it was not supported by any medical evidence, the learned trial Court cancelled the bail and forfeited the bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by him. Warrants of arrest were also ordered to be issued against the petitioner for 03.07.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will appear before the Court on 03.07.2018 and furnish the fresh bail bonds and surety bonds. The petitioner also undertakes to regularly appear before

the Court.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on the date fixed i.e. 03.07.2018 on which date on furnishing of fresh bail bonds and surety bonds, the petitioner shall be released on bail.

In the meanwhile, the stay of the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed as per order dated 04.06.2018 till 03.07.2018.
