Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.300 dated 31.12.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 506 IPC (Section 307 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Sadar, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that as per FIR, no injury has been attributed to the petitioners. Petitioner No.3-Vishan has been attributed injury with a brick blow on the left hand finger of Sandeep, who is brother-in-law of the complainant. He further states that the other co-accused, namely, Oma and Bhateri have already been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-22782-2018 titled as "Oma and another Versus State of Haryana" vide order dated 30.05.2018. Petitioner Nos.1 to 3, namely, Manjeet @ Manjit, Binder @ Mangloo and Vishan are in custody since 22.02.2018, 10.03.2018 and 20.04.2018 respectively and there is no other case against them.

On the other hand, learned State counsel states that considering the injury, Section 307 IPC has been added at later stage and so far as bail to co-accused, namely, Oma and Bhateri is concerned, they were admitted on bail while considering the age factor.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioners No.1 to 3 are statedly in custody since 22.02.2018, 10.03.2018 and 20.04.2018 respectively. Challan in the case has been presented and charges are yet to be framed. In this manner, trial in the case will take sufficient long time and no useful purpose will be served to keep the petitioners behind the bar.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, prayer of the petitioners is accepted and the petitioner Nos.1 to 3, namely, Manjeet @ Manjit, Binder @ Mangloo and Vishan are ordered to be admitted on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands allowed.
