The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.404 dated 24.04.2018, registered under Sections 379-A IPC, at Police Station Thanesar City District Kurukshetra.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he snatched the purse from the complainant containing Rs.400/- - Rs.500/-. After arrest of the petitioner, an amount of Rs.2,000/- has been recovered from him. The petitioner is in custody since 24.04.2018.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner is involved in other cases also and now he is on bail in the said cases.

The conclusion of trial will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Yuvraj Anand is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Kurukshetra, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
