The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.367 dated 16.04.2018, registered at Police Station Thanesar City, District Kurukshetra, under Section 379-A IPC.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner snatched the purse of the complainant which contained Rs.2,000/- in cash, a mobile phone with sim card and certain other identity cards.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 26.04.2018 and that the investigation is complete and therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody indefinitely as the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date.

Learned State counsel, however, submits that recovery has been effected from the petitioner and thus, it is clear that he has committed the offence.

Considering the fact that the investigation is complete and that the trial is likely to take some time to complete, it would be appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed

and the petitioner Yuvraj Anand, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
