Appeal is against the orders of the trial as well as Appellate Court dated 29.01.1994 and 09.03.1996, respectively.

Respondent Phuman Singh was a Driver. On 17.07.1986, General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Ferozepur imposed the penalty of stoppage of one annual increment with cumulative effect. Respondent aggrieved by the penalty order filed suit. Suit was decreed in his favour on 29.01.1994. Feeling aggrieved by the decree, appellant-State preferred appeal before the Appellate Court in which they have suffered an order on 09.03.1996. Hence, the present appeal.

During pendency of this appeal, respondent is stated to have died. LRs have not brought on record and Appellant-State have not made out a case as to how decree can be interfered so also Appellate Court order.

Appeal stands dismissed.
