The present petition has been filed seeking issuance of directions to the State to carry out impartial investigation in the cross case registered vide DDR No.20 dated 8.12.2017 under Sections 452, 326, 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 in FIR No.97 dated 21.9.2017 registered under Sections 325, 452, 379-B, 148 and 149 of IPC at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran and also for issuance of directions to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and also to hand over the investigation of aforesaid FIR to some independent agency.

The learned counsel has submitted that despite registration of a cross case, the accused in the cross case are roaming freely and that the police is helping and protecting them.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

I find that vide order dated 17.11.2017 (Annexure P-6), this Court had already issued directions for protecting life and liberty. In these circumstances, there is no necessity to issue any fresh direction.

As regards the prayer for handing over the investigation to some independent agency concerned, the learned counsel submits that he withdraws the said prayer at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the matter so as to ensure that the cross case registered vide DDR No.20 dated 8.12.2017 under Sections 452, 326, 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 in FIR No.97 dated 21.9.2017 registered under Sections 325, 452, 379-B, 148 and 149 of IPC is fairly investigated. A copy of this petition be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned so as to enable him to dispose of the matter expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from today.
