Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to provide adequate security and protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from the investigating officer states that Anju Rani-mother of petitioner No.1-Anchal Rani has made a statement that she has no objection to the marriage solemnized by her daughter Anchal Rani. He further states that even petitioner No.1-Anchal Rani has also made a statement to the effect that she does not apprehend any threat to her life and liberty.

Photocopies of the statements of Anchal Rani, Anju Rani, Rakesh Kumar and Rajesh Kumar, produced in the Court are taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid stand, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of as such.
