DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed by petitioner-Jai Pal Singh under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to him in case FIR No.29 dated 24.02.2018 registered under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case and no role has been attributed to him. He is in custody since 28.02.2018 and has been implicated only because of offence under Sections 148/149 IPC. Learned counsel also submits that after presentation of challan, the charges have been framed and even a single witness has not been examined so far. Learned counsel also submits that co-accused, namely, Hardeep Singh has been allowed regular bail in ***Criminal Misc. No.M-21185 of 2018.***

Learned State counsel has not disputed the custody period as well as stage of trial and also the fact that no role has been attributed to him.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and by considering that the petitioner has been implicated only because of offence under Sections 148/149 IPC; he is in custody since 28.02.2018; trial may take long time to conclude and no useful purpose would be served by keeping him in custody; that co-accused, namely, Hardeep Singh has been granted regular bail in ***Criminal Misc. No.M-21185 of 2018***, the present petition is allowed and petitioner, namely, Jai Pal Singh is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
