Petitioner Suresh Mandal has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.68 dated 03.05.2016, registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana, under Sections 302, 307, 325 and 323 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The present FIR was recorded on the statement of complainant Pooja Yadav daughter of the deceased, on allegations stated that the present accused to whom she is addressing as her father, came to the house and had given several blows with iron rod on the head of her mother and when she raised raula, the present petitioner ran away from the spot.

Keeping in view the serious allegations; nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed with the direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial by giving short adjournment and if required, adjourning the case on day to day basis. The Investigating Officer/SHO of the concerned police station is directed to produce all the remaining witnesses for examination before the learned trial Court on the next 2-3 days.
