By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.157 dated 14.6.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 427, 148 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

The FIR was got registered at the instance of one Tarsem Lal, who alleged that his neighbour Rajinder Singh @ Rinku engages dancers for wedding functions and that the complainant's son Mohit Kumar had requested Rinku politely for not to bring the dancers there as it is a residential area where ladies also resides. It is alleged that after a short while Rajinder Singh @ Rinku along with his sister's son Jassi and two unknown persons came there and entered into his house armed with screw driver and dagger and caused injuries on his head and when his brother tried to save

him he was also inflicted injuries and the accused also took away an amount of ₹ 10,000/- from his pocket.

Notice of the present petition was issued to the State.

Vide order dated 2.7.2018 the petitioners were granted interim bail and had been directed to join investigation.

The learned State counsel has informed that the petitioners have already joined the investigation.

A perusal of the MLR in respect of the complainant-Tarsem Lal reveals that he is shown to have sustained two injuries. While one injury is described as a pain on the back of right side of his chest, the other injury is described as a lacerated wound. The MLR in respect of Baljeet Kumar reveals that he has sustained three reddish aberrations. None of the injury is a 'grievous injury'.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that the petitioners have already joined investigation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 2.7.2018 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
