This petition has been filed by petitioners-Manoj Kumar and
Laksmi Kumari.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No.1 is
natural guardian of petitioner No.2- Laksmi Kumari, whereas averment
reveals that petitioner No.2 has been married with respondent No.9.

Neither there is affidavit on behalf of Laksmi Kumari nor she is
signatory on the power of attorney. In these circumstances, it cannot be said
that petitioner No.1 is natural guardian.

However, after arguing for some time, learned counsel for the
petitioners states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition
with liberty to approach the concerned authorities for the relief claimed in
the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
