JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 14 dated 5.2.2018, under Sections 313, 323, 376 and 506 IPC registered at Women Police Station, Panipat, District Panipat

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the allegations as set out in the FIR are wholly unsustainable. In fact, this is a case where the parties were living together of their own free will and out of which relationship a child has also born. It is contended that the allegations that a video clipping has been made has also been negated. Even the allegations as made of abortion by subsequent pregnancy has been found to be untrue. Learned counsel further submits that charges have been framed and the trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served

by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana, appearing on behalf of the respondent-State submits that the nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner are of serious nature and as such he does not deserves the concession of regular bail.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner and the complainant were in consensual relationship and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
