INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.58 dated 13.03.2018 under Sections 307, 506, 295, 427, 380, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion.

Ms.Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that neither the petitioner has been named nor any role has been attributed to him in the FIR. He has been nominated in this case on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused.

Neither any weapon has been recovered from the petitioner nor any injury

has been attributed to him even after the investigation.

The petitioner has been in custody since 13.03.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
